Welcome back after the half term vacation and I hope all of you are well and healthy. Having had a mid-week break, as well as the holiday, I have noticed how much energy and enthusiasm all of our community have in both schools - the children are working hard, enjoying school and respecting the continued restrictions we have regarding COVID-19.

I am delighted to say that as from Monday 9th November, the parents will be allowed back into both schools at all times, but I kindly ask that you observe these five (5) strict measures:

- 1) If coming into either school, we ask that you don't loiter in groups of parents, but go straight to the cafe or reception with the requirement you have.
- 2) Parents must be wearing gloves and masks at all times.
- 3) Parents must have their temperature taken upon entry.
- 4) Foot covers must be worn by all parents.
- 5) No more than 6 (Saint Petersburg) or 8 (Moscow) parents in the cafes at any one time.

As from Monday 9th November, we kindly ask that all parents wear shoe covers when entering the building.
