

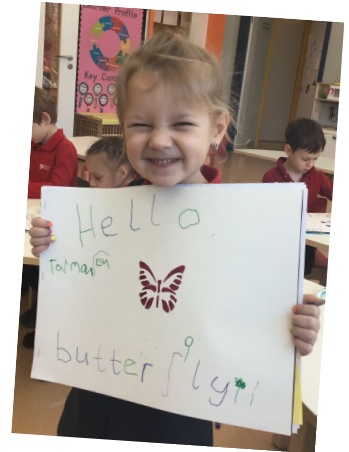

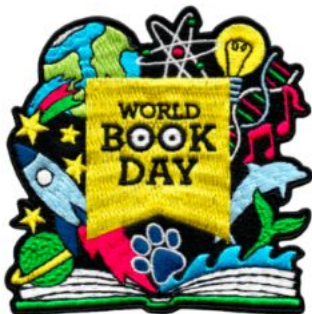

Security Access

We would like to advise that as of Wednesday 3rd of March 2021, Brookes Moscow are going to launch a security access system at the main entrance. For students in year 3-6 the keys will be distributed by the Front Desk Reception in exchange for a signed Act of Acceptance. There are no changes to the entry requirement for students in our Early Years from Pre Nursery to Year 2 inclusive. The Act of Acceptance will be sent by email directly to parents of all students in the associated year groups.



Please be aware that it is the responsibility of the student to look after the key. Replacement of lost keys will incur a charge which must be made in advance of the new key being issued.
